



Celebrate Bandera Parade

September 4th, 2010

RULES

1. Parade begins at 11:00 AM rain or shine. Bring rain gear or plastic covering if needed.
2. Line-up will begin at 9:30 AM.
3. Holders of political office are welcome. Those campaigning for office are also welcome.
4. A licensed driver must drive autos and large vehicles. Small vehicles (lawn tractors, mini bikes, etc.) must be operated by a person age 12 or over.
5. The parade committee retains the right to refuse an entry, float, unit, or individual not conforming to standards of the committee. Failure to comply with Parade Rules will result in removal from the parade formation and will affect future invitations.
6. Riding horses double or shooting firearms, caps., etc. is NOT ALLOWED. All horses must have proof of negative coggins.
7. Drivers or participants may consume NO alcoholic beverages during the parade.
8. Celebrate Bandera assumes no responsibility for accidents or loss of any kind.
9. No articles whatsoever (gum, candy, flyers, flowers, etc.) may be thrown from any parade entry. This is for the safety of the participants as well as the spectators. It is OK for someone to walk along side an entry and distribute items. This will be enforced!!
10. An adult leader must accompany bands.
11. Each youth group shall be represented by at least two adult supervisors who shall be responsible for their group following all parade rules. Adult groups shall name a contact person.
12. No loud sirens and/or horns may be sounded during the parade so as not to spook any horses or cattle.
13. When disbanding, please DO NOT block the flow of traffic for participants behind you.
